In keeping with AB 705, students who have graduated from a US High School within the last 10 years are eligible to enroll in transfer level math, specifically Math 227. Students may enroll in the following depending on their grade in High School Intermediate Algebra or Integrated Math 3 (or equivalent or higher):
