**Test-taking Strategies:** This workshop has been broken into three parts:

**Test-taking 1:** Focus on different study methods for your learning styles and for specific test types.

**Test-taking 2:** Focus on strategies for taking the written test (the essay, paragraph, and/or short answer).

**Test-taking 3:** Focus on strategies for the objective test (multiple choice, true/false, etc.).

**Attend just one workshop or all three! Bring your textbooks and notes!**

**Vocabulary:** Did you know that the majority of the words in the English language are not English? Build vocabulary using morphemic analysis. Learn over 250 words this semester. Students of all levels are welcome to attend.

**Working through Academic Anxiety:** Learn to identify triggers, recognize signs of anxiety, and create strategies to work through academic stress.
