CLERY TIMELY WARNING HATE CRIME - L.A. PIERCE COLLEGE

On 11/03/21, L.A. County Sheriff's Department received a report of a hate crime that occurred at L.A. Pierce College. Several flyers were found posted on campus threatening harm to individuals of a specific ethnicity. The flyers depicted several photographed students and included racially-motivated threats. This is an ongoing investigation with no suspect information at this time.
