- The poetry or talk should be in keeping with the theme of the event, “Revolutions and Evolutions: Body, Mind and Soul” in whichever form or manner the artist defines these concepts. Judges reserve the right to determine suitability of submission and whether all categories will be awarded.
- The poetry or talk is limited to no more than 3 minutes in length.
- **A completed Student Entry Form must be filled out before entry into the competition. You may print out the Entry Form and bring it with you on the day of the event. The Student Poetry Jam will start at 3:30 p.m. and last until no later than 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, February 25, 2010 at the Great Hall The winners will be announced shortly thereafter. There is no entry fee.**
- All submissions must be original. Entries containing copyrighted material without express written permission will not be accepted and are not eligible to win.
- Entries will be evaluated based on their quality, originality, creativity and appeal.
- All decisions made by the judges are final and non-disputable.
