Thanks to the generosity of The Bernard Osher Foundation, thousands of California Community College students, like you, may receive an Osher Scholarship as part of the California Community Colleges Scholarship Endowment. Mr. Osher's vision is to "not only benefit the community college students of today but countless more for years to come."

Criteria

- Student attending Fall 2011 and Spring 2012 semesters must have completed 24 or more "degree applicable" semester units (or the equivalent) at the time of the initial scholarship disbursement. Priority will be given to full-time students.
- Student must be enrolled at least half-time (6 or more units) during all terms in which the award remains active.
- Student must have received a California Community College Board of Governor's Fee Waiver.
- Awards will be adjusted based on enrolled status and determined as follows:
 - Full-time (12 or more units per term) = up to \$500/semester
 - Three-quarter-time (9 - 11.99 units per term) = up to \$375/semester
 - Half-time (6 - 8.99 units per term) = up to \$250/semester

Amount of award: Annual awards are up to \$1,000 each and will be pro-rated based upon enrollment
