Research

- **\$642 million was awarded in sponsored research in 2009-2010**
- **The university runs one of the world's fastest supercomputers and one of the most powerful lasers**
- **About 800 patents have been awarded to the university**

Athletics

- Big 12 conference sport

- Application requirements
 - Application
 - Transcripts
 - 2 essays
 - Major-specific items
 - Resume
 - *Optional: Letter of recommendation
- Summer/Fall deadline: March 1st
- Spring Deadline: October 1st

Things to do in the city of Austin...

- Barton Springs: The three-acre spring-fed pool stays at 68 degrees year round.
